TAX BENEFITS

Bequests left to the Kidney Cancer Association are not subject to estate taxes and provide an estate tax deduction.

Retirement assets can also be used to fund a charitable trust to provide for loved ones. The trust can pay income to your loved ones for the period of time you designate, after which the trust balance will be distributed to us.
