About Kidney Cancer



Kidney cancer is about twice as common in men as in women

75% of kidney cancer diagnoses are Clear Cell RCC



The average age for someone to be diagnosed with kidney cancer is 64

- Blood in the urine
- Abdominal mass
- Back or flank pain
- Low blood count (anemia)

## RISK FACTORS

- Smoking
- Obesity
- High blood pressure
- Family history
- Genetics

## EDUCATION

As the first and largest kidney cancer advocacy group, the KCA is the only organization to promote scientific advances and education globally. The KCA provides opportunities for healthcare professionals through:

### Symposiums

European International Kidney Cancer Symposium (EIKCS) – Spring  
International Kidney Cancer Symposium (IKCS) – Fall

### Continuing Medical Education (CME) programming

Free accredited sessions for healthcare professionals to further their kidney cancer education and clinical knowledge.

### Mentorship Program

Leading kidney cancer specialists are paired with promising physicians to expose them to research and clinical practice and contribute to their success.

## RESEARCH

Funding research has been a pillar of the KCA's mission since the organization's inception. The KCA funds **\$1.375 million** in research grants annually.

### Advanced Discovery Award (ADA)

Two \$500,000 grants awarded to scientist/clinician teams proposing new research that will make an immediate impact in kidney cancer.

### Young Investigator Award (YIA)

Four \$75,000 grants awarded to promising researchers planning to pursue an investigative career in kidney cancer.

### Psychosocial Focus Award

One \$75,000 grant awarded to researchers investigating the psychosocial issues facing people impacted by kidney cancer.

## ADVOCATE

The KCA is active in legislative advocacy efforts, specifically by encouraging individuals to contact their congressional leaders through our letter-writing campaigns. Through our online advocacy portal, individuals write their representatives and the House Committee on Appropriations to advocate for more government-funded research.

As part of the Defense Health Research Consortium, we work to protect and enrich government funding for medical research programs. Government funding for kidney cancer has grown steadily from \$10 million in 2016 to \$50 million in 2021.
